

# Unification

## Abstract

3000 years of known history, humanity has always searched for answers to their physical and spiritual existence. Great men in the past have tried to do something, something quite different from the rest of the people of their times. For years, we have sought for treasures, information from the past, something that explains our existence. Answers to questions like did God create us, is there a destiny for humanity. And finally, the answer seems to lie in front of us. This essay is explorative without scientific references to attempt to answer questions.

## 1 Homo Sapiens Sapiens

150,000 years ago during the Holocene period (geological period) something important happened. ## 2 From Tribes to Civilisation

If you have read Stephen Baxter's 'Evolution', or any book on evolution, you would know that the first Home Habilis, to the Homo Erectus to Homo Ergaster started out as cave dwellers and later found arboreal homes and then went on to the Savannah. None of us know whether there is enough evidence to prove this or we are speculative about our evolution.

The 3000 years whose history we believe is documented in bits and pieces at least tell us that humans evolved from some sort of common ancestors. Much of today's thought process, we seem to owe it to the Greeks, and almost all of it to Aristotle, his students and their students thereafter. Much of the knowledge of many other independent civilisations - Egyptian, sumerian, Harappan, mandarin, ... the names go on, is similar. Except for the knowledge of a great flood (which we today believe is a collection of independent floods that marked the end of a glacial period) greco-Latin roots seemed to have established the future of our civilisation and much of today.

### **3 The Unifiers**

After all this knowledge and disparity was created, great men were born who did not seek glory, who did not want to take things from everyone else alive. Instead these men wanted to give back to life, to civilisation, something they believed in. It all started with a feeling of superiority, a centre of the world. An idea to unify not just the tribes but all the civilisations. This all started to prove a feeling of superiority, interspersed with mercy, to unify all that was known in the world.

#### **3.1 Alexander, The Great, ShahanShah, Pharaoh of Egypt**

Alexander the Great, Alexander 3, King of Macedonia, believed that there was no one race that was superior, no one idea that was great, that all could be united, that his teachers (Aristotle) could have been wrong. And yet, who would listen to a tribe of shepherds, the Greeks thought they were superior, the Persians thought they were superior, someone had to erase these lines that separated them, the superiority complex that drove the tribes to exist, that drove the people.

He had to learn the Greek way of life, the Greek way of fighting, the Greek ways of philosophy and politics and then he set out on an impossible mission - to unify the world. He set out as a general, to conquer and bring together all under one kingdom. His father Philip, beat the Greeks to submission, put down their superiority complex - a group of those who were merely known to be shepherds now dictated the Greeks. With this unification he went after Persia, and became the first western general to conquer the east. He fought people who were different, and he learnt to blend into them, to create a new world. he was 2000 years ahead of his time, with just horses and parchment, he unified Egypt, Greece, Macedonia, Persia, Bactria and every known place that had been mapped before. Like all those who followed him he showed mercy to let people believe in unification. Something we humans today, still can't achieve, believe we are one and the same, be together, love each other. He tried to do this alternating between mercy and the lack of it.

He went to India, where he thought the world had ended, and yet he was the first to learn that it was too big for one human to rule, nothing Aristotle taught seemed to be true. He was ambushed, defeated and had to retreat back home and died a sick man. ### **3.2 Julius Caesar, Caesar - God, Emperor, Beyond all Humans**

It is documented that the Cholas attempted this in India far later, tried to create a grassroot political system, what the 20th century 'Mahatma' Gandhi, called Gramaraj.

Unfortunately, we humans had to fall back to our mammalian weakness, the alpha male order. Some were created simply more skilled, talented and greater than everyone else. These men turned back and created Kingdoms all over again, back from the Republic, backed away from the second attempt at unification. These men, again were merciful and merciless at the same time (before the quantum theory was born). He never took to the sword, but performed deeds that were only explainable as true son of God, Yahweh. We now call these deeds miracles, inexplicable, unexplainable by our rational thought process. These deeds created faith, recreated a new version of the Judaic religion, we now call Christianity.

### **3.5 Queen Elizabeth, Creator of Great Britain**

After several years of the religion, a small island unified by a chieftan Uther Pendragon, later Arthur Pendragon, created a monarchy. Fiefdoms, Oligarchies, Political complications all prevailed until a lady with an iron will, one who was never thought to inherit the monarchy came to the throne.
